Mr. Lam Kwong-siu, FEC Independent Non-Executive Director, Awarded Grand Bauhinia Medal by the Chief Executive of the HKSAR

Over the years, Mr. Lam has been actively involved in public and community service, with a strong commitment to youth development and the advancement of education in Hong Kong. The award of the GBM reflects the HKSAR Government's recognition of Mr. Lam's longstanding contributions to society and to the development of Hong Kong.

GBM is the highest award under the HKSAR Honours and Awards System, to recognise the selected person's life-long and highly significant contribution to the well-being of Hong Kong. A total of 466 individuals from different walks of life with diverse backgrounds were awarded honours by the Chief Executive this year. They have made significant contributions to Hong Kong in different areas, benefitting various domains and sectors of the community.

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
